Scenario Planning: Implications for Individual Stations

GOALS:

- 1. Practice and verify the usefulness of these terms and processes for individual station planning.**
- 2. Brainstorm with peers about how we will position our stations to thrive under the proposed scenarios.**

QUESTION:

“Your station intends to be successful no matter which of the four scenarios unfolds. Over the next 3 years, what are the ‘No Brainers’, ‘No Gainers’, ‘No Regrets’ you will undertake to strengthen and position your station for that future?”

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Work independently to answer the question for your own station using sheets at the end of these instructions. (Suggested time: 5 minutes)**
 - Write down all the “No Brainers” ideas on the Worksheet Page marked “No Brainers”; “No Gainers” on the “No Gainers” page, etc.**
- 2. Table discussion of actions that fall into the categories of “No Brainers”, “No Gainers” and “No Regrets” when your station prepares for a world characterized by the four scenarios. (Suggested time: 25 minutes)**
- 3. Convene for Full Room Discussion. (Suggested time: 30 minutes)**
